Philosopher In Cockpit

BIEN HOA, Vietnam (AP) — Ruddy-faced Colver Jones is not just a pilot, he's a cockpit philosopher—twice as old as many of his flying mates and some of them a legend.

Peering over an undisciplined auburn mustache, the 48-year-old captain fixes young helicopter pilots with a baleful stare and warns: "There is no such thing as an old, bold pilot."

In Vietnam, however, there are plenty of young, bold pilots and Jones is dedicated to seeing that they age gracefully.

Having flown with a gunship company in Vietnam four years ago, Jones is now ending his second tour as a pilot with the 20th Engineer Brigade. The engineer pilots fly cargo and liaison missions, haul dignitaries and command officers around, and maintain courier flights throughout the Mekong Delta.

It sounds safe enough but nothing is really safe in Vietnam, Jones recalls a routine ferry mission to Saigon's airport one morning when the chopper, taking off just ahead of him, was hit by a burst of fire from a sudden skirmish on the ground—one crewman was killed with a bullet in the head.

"I always try and tell the new pilots with us to forget about all those wild combat stories and start fresh. There are no more instructors out here. You start learning from right now."

"It's a funny thing, I never met a kid who wouldn't listen." They listen, perhaps, because Colver Jones is known as "The Fox." In 25 years of flying he has had only one major accident, and he walked away from that one.

That was a decade ago during a stunt flying surveying planes for the engineers in Alaska. A submerged bit of thawing tundra ripped the floats from his light plane during a landing.

Screwworm Fly Epidemic Increases

WASHINGTON (AP) — Unless a current epidemic of screwworm fly in the Southwest is brought under control, it may be necessary to require livestock inspection at state borders, the Department of Agriculture said Wednesday.

The department said 851 cases of infestation have been reported so far this year in 50 counties of Texas, New Mexico, Arizona and California — highest count since 1963.

Texas has reported 602 cases, Arizona 133, California 54 and New Mexico 5, the department said.

Dr. E. E. Saulmon, research director in the animal health division, warned that the pest could reach states which have been free of it for many years.

The current outbreak originated in Mexico, Saulmon added.

More than three billion sterile male flies have been released in Mexico and the United States this year in an effort to break the reproductive cycle.

Judge Declares 'Murph the Surf' Legally Insane

MIAMI, Fla. (AP) — Jewel thief Jack "Murph the Surf" Murphy, said to consider himself a modern day Robin Hood, was declared legally insane Tuesday night.

Criminal Court Judge Carling Stedman canceled Murphy's murder and robbery trials after declaring him "mentally unable to aid his defense counsel or understand charges against him."

"The defendant is adjudicated insane and incapable of standing trial at this time," Stedman said at the Dade County hearing.

Dr. David Rothenberg, a psychiatrist, testified at the 10-hour hearing that "Jack Murphy is suffering from an extreme mental disorder, is extremely dangerous and belongs in a mental hospital."

Rothenberg quoted Murphy 30, as saying during the May 3 examination, "I am like a Robin Hood. I'm here to help those that need help, and help those that have been wronged, and to punish those who do wrong."

The judge committed Murphy to a state mental hospital for an undetermined term and ordered him held under maximum security.

Opponent Of U. S. Bases Wins Election

REYKJAVIK, Iceland (AP) — Kristjan Eldjarn, director of the national museum, has won a landslide victory in Iceland's presidential election.

Eldjarn, 52, a nationalist who once opposed the presence of U.S. airbases in his country, won 65 per cent of the vote.

His rival was nearly twice that of Gunnar Thoroddsen, a diplomat and son-in-law of outgoing President Asger Asgrason.

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
